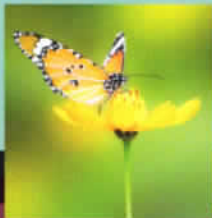


PROJECT LOVE'S MISSION

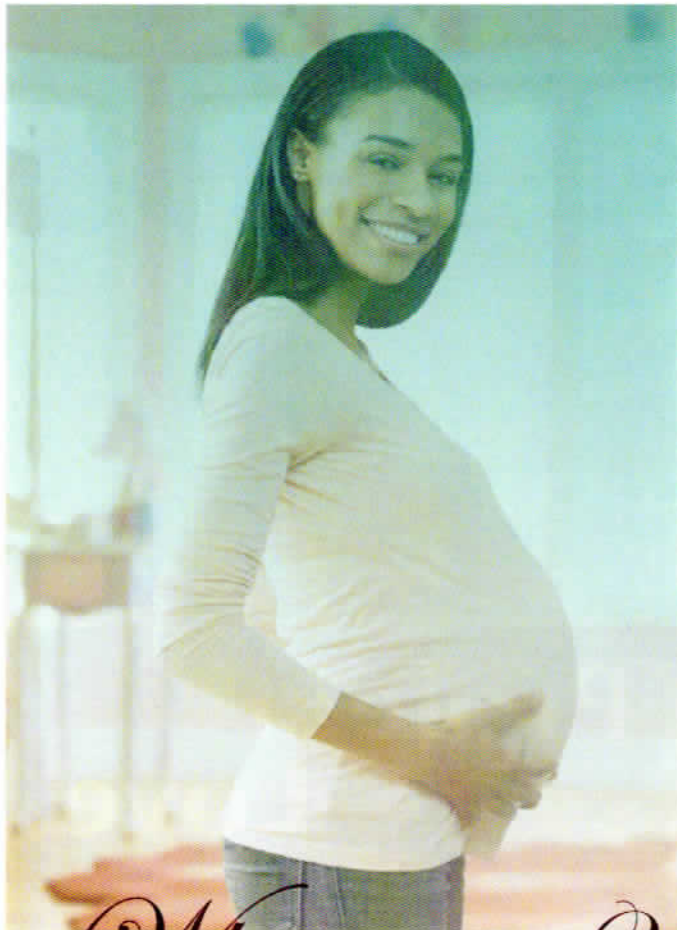

Whom do we serve?

Applicants are screened by their counselors at Pregnancy Centers throughout Illinois. Counselors submit applications on behalf of their clients to Project Love for review according to the following guidelines:

- Must be a resident of the state of Illinois.
- Must be either pregnant or have had a child in the last 12 months
- Must be doing all they can to solve their problems themselves.
- Need is urgent, and it has been determined that Project Love is a last resort.
- Only one grant is given per pregnancy and is issued to her creditor.
